Kid's CLUB (Children dismissed after worship and praise songs) for ages 5 through 3rd Grade - Armor of God.

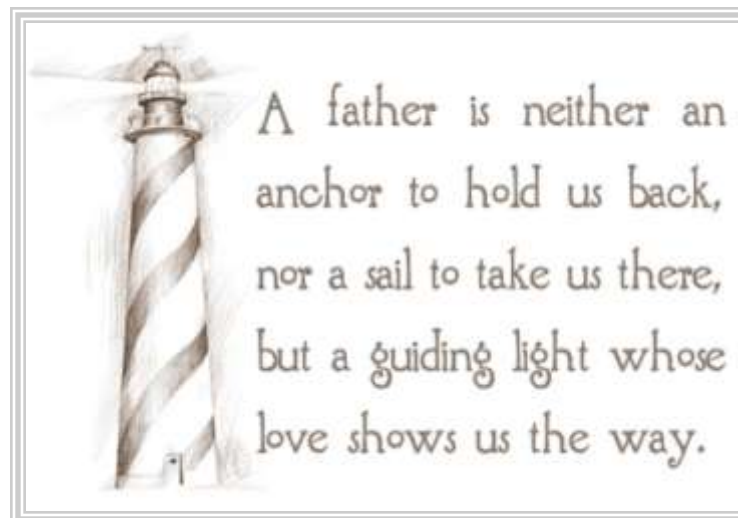
