JaM (Jesus And Me) Sessions: Sunday School class for students 5 to 12 years old from 10 a.m. to 10:45 a.m.

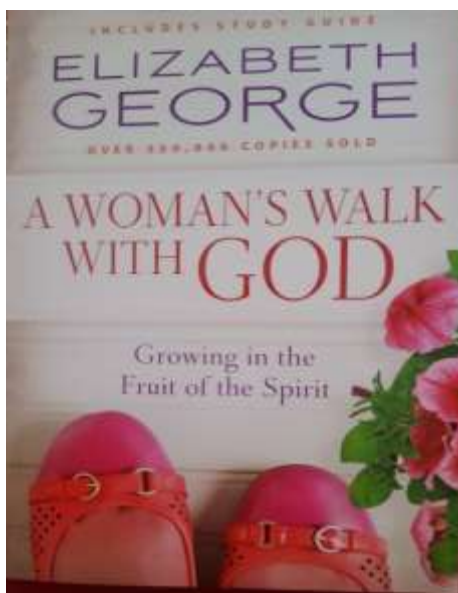
Kid's CLUB (Children dismissed after worship and praise songs) for ages 5 through 3rd Grade - Camp EDGE.
