"Moved to Action"  
Nehemiah

- I. Greatest Commandment – Matt. 22:37-40
  1. Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.
  2. Love your neighbor as yourself.
  3. Use your passion not just your gifts.Passion – intense, driving, or overmastering feeling or conviction
- II. Nehemiah
  1. Nehemiah is a Jewish cupbearer for King Artaxerxes of Persia.
  2. He learned of the state of disrepair in Jerusalem and was moved. Nehemiah 1:3-4
  3. Nehemiah sought God. 1:4 and 2:4-5
  4. Nehemiah faces intense opposition. 4:1-10
  5. Nehemiah leads in the completion of the wall. 6:15-16
- III. What is your passion?
  1. Have you sought God's input?
  2. Does it stir raw emotion within you?
  3. Does it move you to action? Even irrational action?
  4. Will you continue even in the face of opposition?
  5. Is it something you would do even if no one knew?
  6. All passions are important and valid!
  7. How can your passion be turned into ministry?
