#### The Truth Has Come!

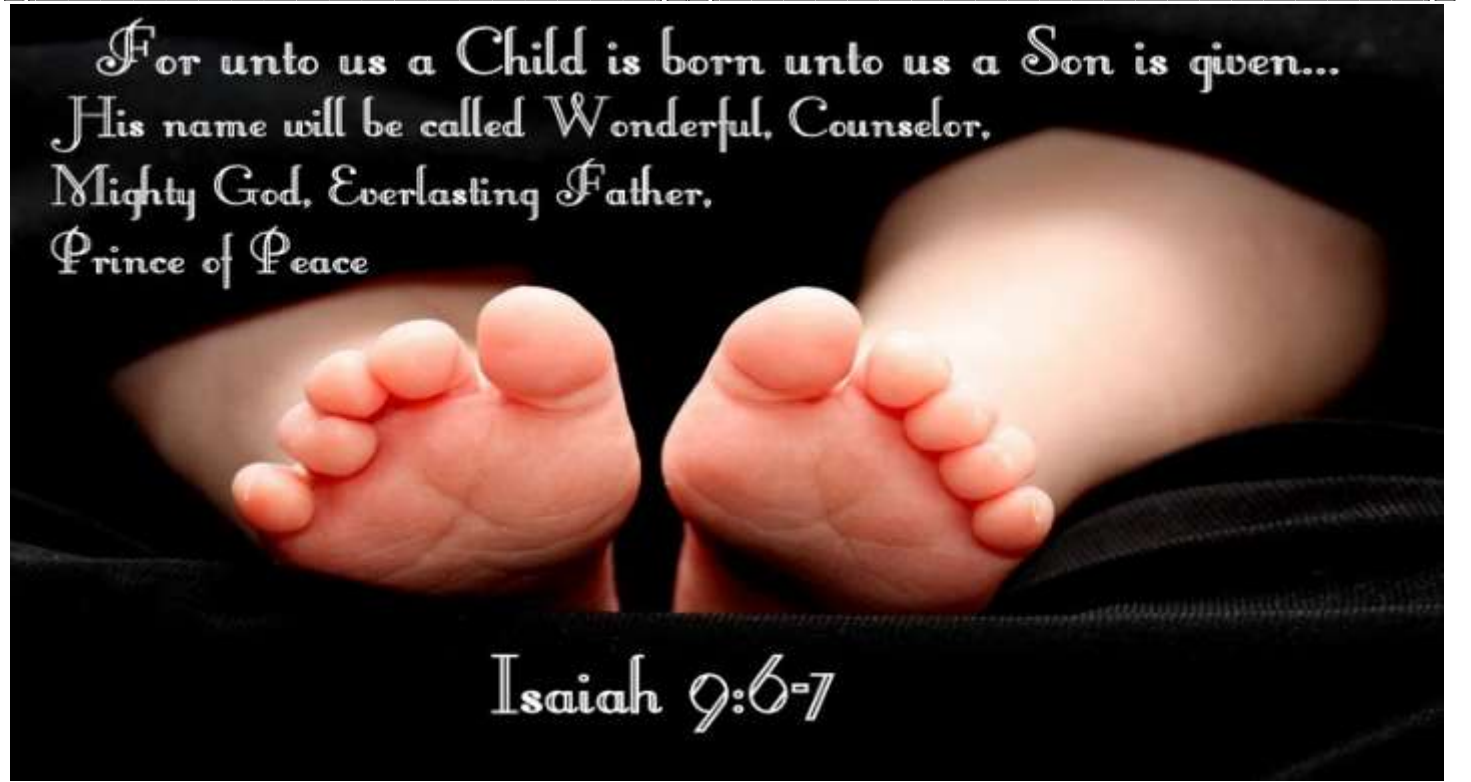
Matthew 2:1-6
