I Samuel 18-22

1. David
 - a man after God's own heart
 - obedient and humble
 - anointed to be king
 - defeated the giant
 - ready to be king **WRONG!!!**
2. David goes through one of the most difficult times in his life.
3. Saul tries to kill David three times!
4. David loses all of his support
 - position in the army and the King's court
 - his wife
 - his mentor
 - his closest friend
 - his self-respect
5. David hits bottom in a cave.
6. David is now ready for God to use him.

2. What things in your life are/can be substitutes for God?
3. What distracts your focus from God?
