Sermon Notes

"God of the Covenant"

A covenant is an agreement between two parties that requires a commitment or action from both parties.

Abram Genesis 12

1. God would bring from him a **great nation**.
2. Abram had to **leave** his country and **go to the land** that God would show him.
3. The sign of the covenant was a **smoking firepot** with a blazing torch passing between the sacrificed animals. Genesis 15:9-10
4. The fulfillment comes when Abram's descendants become the nation of **Israel**.

Introduction of the New Covenant Luke 22:14-20

1. Bread = The **Body** of Jesus given for you.
2. Cup = The **Blood** of Jesus which is the New Covenant which was poured out for the forgiveness of your sins.

Fulfillment of the New Covenant John 3:16

1. Everlasting life through the **shed blood** of Jesus.
2. Without the **shedding** of blood there is no forgiveness of sin.

Acceptance of the New Covenant

1. Everyone **sins**. Romans 3:23
2. **Punishment** for **sin** is death/**gift** of God is Eternal life Romans 6:23
3. God shows His **love** for us through the death of Jesus Romans 5:8
4. Confess with your **mouth** and **believe** in your heart that Jesus is Lord! Romans 10:9-10
5. You **will** be saved! Romans 10:13
